Site Information

During the removal of the external insulation it is advisable to remove any pictures, ornaments etc from your window sills along with hanging ornaments/ pictures from external walls as a precaution. The vibration of the machinery could possible cause them to fall and potentially break.

Please refrain from opening your windows during working hours. This will reduce the noise levels and prevent dust etc entering your home.

Southey Court and Castleton

The Mast Climbers will continue to be installed to the side and front of the building. This will involve scaffolding alterations, installation of Mast Climbing equipment along with a power supply.

While works to the rear of the buildings continues, it is important, again for Health and Safety issues, that everyone refrains from using the rear doors between the hours of 8.30am and 5.00pm while the temporary works are being carried out.

In the case of a Fire, please push the plastic barriers and exit through the Rear and Front doors

The car park at Southey will remain closed for the time being.

Fitzgerald Court

Scaffolding, Mast Climbers and a power supply will continue to be erected around the building.

Due to the nature of the work and to maintain the highest Health and Safety procedures it will be necessary to close the front car park outside Fitzgerald Court. The car park will remain closed for the duration of the works while the area is used for storage and skips.

There will be a Council Highways Road Closure Permit to allow for this area to be closed off, heras fenced off and a pedestrian walkway placed in situ.

We apologise to all for the inconvenience this may cause but if you could please find an alternative parking site for the duration of these works it will be appreciated.

Once the Permit is live any vehicles within the area will be enclosed.

We will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum and I would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation
